## OLD P. A. WINS AGAIN

Andover Takes the Third Consecutive Victory From Exeter on the Exeter Campus by the Score of 9 to 6.

EXETER, N.H., Nov. 9, 1907

Andover defeated Exeter here today on the latter's field by the score of 9 to 6, in a contest which was watched by thousands of people, who were followers of either the blue or the crimson. The cheering sections of the two schools faced each other across the gridiron, and both cheered constantly in support of their team. The two sections marched to the field a few minutes before the game, the Exeter line headed by its band.

The Exeter team came on the field first, led by Captain Power at 1.58. The Andover eleven followed soon after at 2.03, led by Captain Merritt. The teams were applauded by both sides of the field and took a few minutes for practice.

### The Game in Detail

Captain Merritt of Andover won the toss and chose to defend the north goal.

At 2.23 Lewis kicked off for Exeter to Jackson, on the 10 yard line. Jackson made 5 yards. Porter made 3 yards on a straight-buck. Aechtler punts to Exeter who fumbles, Porter gaining for Andover. Aechtler makes

a forward pass to Coates who makes 10 yards. Murchie cross-bucks for 3 yards. Murchie forward passes to Ely who makes 15 yards. Murchie then bucks 2 yards. Porter is held. Aechtler forward passes but Sharon of Exeter gets the ball.

On a fake kick Sharon makes 5 yards, but fails to gain on trying same trick. Lewis punts to Murchie who fumbles. Exeter's ball on 50 yard line. Double forward pass to Baker nets 10 yards. Ross makes an inside kick to Ely on 5 yard line. Porter bucks for 4 yards. Exeter is penalized 5 yards for off-side play. Aechtler punts to Sharon who fumbles but regains the ball on the 55 yard line. Lewis makes a short kick to Porter who gains nothing. Murchie forward passes but Lewis gains the ball on the 50 yard line. Sharon forward passes but the ball touches the ground and Exeter is penalized 15 yards. Sharon is held around end on a fake kick. Lewis punts to Merritt who does not gain. Aechtler makes 6 yards.

Lewis gets the ball for Exeter. On a forward pass Baker nets 5 yards. Exeter is penalized 15 yards for not touching the ball on a double forward pass.

Lewis punts to Merritt who gains 15 yards. Jackson is held. Murchie punts to Sharon who gains 3 yards.

Exeter is held on two plays, Lewis then punts to Murchie who gains 20 yards. Murchie fumbles and loses 5 yards. Sharon gains 15 yards on short kick by Murchie. Merritt runs Lewis' punt back 10 yards. Aechtler punts to Sharon who fumbles, the ball rolling to Exeter's 10 yard line. Time taken out for Sharon.

Ross makes 30 yards on fake kick. Power gains 2 yards. Ross short kicks to Porter who gains 10 yards. Andover fumbles but recovers the ball. Aechtler punts to Baker who makes no gain. Ross loses 5 yards. Lewis gains two yards around left end. Murchie runs Lewis' punt back 20 yards. Ely gains 2 yards on Aechtler's forward pass. Jackson gets

Murchie's short kick and gains 20 yards. Porter makes 3 yards through left tackle. Jackson is held and Murchie fails in drop-kick. Ball on Exeter's 10 yard line.

Ross makes 3 yards on fake kick. Sharon loses 10 yards and fumbles, Pierce getting the ball for Andover and making touchdown.

Andover 5, Exeter 0.

Murchie fails to kick goal.

Lewis kicks off to Aechtler on 5 yard line who gains 20 yards. Aechtler punts to Sharon who gains 5 yards. Burns bucks and gains 2 yards. Lewis is held for no gain and then punts to Merritt who gains 3 yards. Andover is held.

Lewis gains 5 yards on Aechtler's punt but Burns fails to gain. Lewis punts but Exeter is penalized 15 yards for holding. Ball on Exeter's 1 yard line. Lewis punts to Merritt who makes a fair catch on Exeter's 35 yard line. Porter kicks goal from placement.

Andover 9, Exeter 0.

Lewis kicks off to Aechtler who gains 20 yards from 10 yard line. Porter bucks for 4 yards and then gains 1 yard. Aechtler punts to Sharon who gains 5 yards.

Ross makes 2 yards on straight-buck. Burns gains 3 yards in same manner. Lewis punts to Merritt who gains 20 yards. Coates gains 10 yards on Aechtler's forward pass. Murchie short kicks, Coates gets ball and makes 20 yards. Andover is held. Murchie gains 2 yards on straight-buck. Murchie fails in try for drop-kick.

Sharon catches the ball and gains 5 yards tackled by Rosendale. Sharon gets 1 yard on fake kick. Lewis fails to gain on double forward pass, tackled by Aechtler. Lewis punts to Merritt, who gains 5 yards. Murchie gains 10 yards around left end. Aechtler is held. Andover is penalized 15 yards. Aechtler punts to Burns. No gain.

Lewis punts to Merritt. No gain. Aechtler punts to Sharon who makes 15 yards. Lewis straight-bucks 4

yards. Burns makes 10 yards around right end. Baker fumbles and Andover's ball on 35 yard line. First half ends.

### SECOND HALF

Dunn was substituted for Murray in the middle of the first half. No changes in line-up, in second half which is 35 minutes in duration.

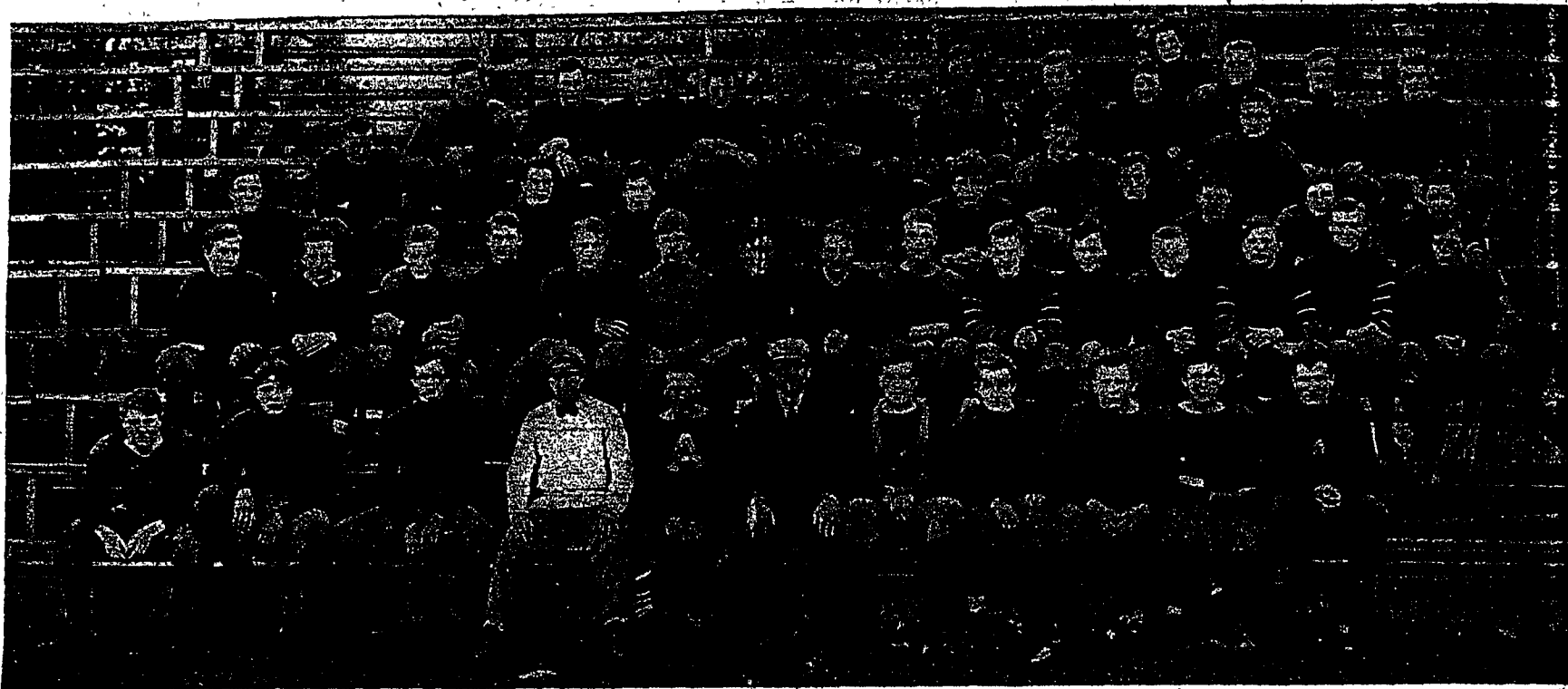

Lewis punts to Merritt who gains 3 yards. Aechtler fumbles and Baker gets the ball for Exeter on 30 yard line. Sharon makes 7 yards around right end. Lewis bucks for 5 yards and adds 6 yards more in 3 plays. Exeter's first down on Andover's 12 yard line. Burns loses 2 yards.

Lewis bucks for 1 yard. Lewis fails in placement kick from 32 yard line.

Aechtler punts out from 25 yard line to Lewis who fumbles, Coates getting the ball. Ely gains 1 yard on forward pass. Andover is penalized 15 yards. Aechtler punts to Sharon who makes 3 yards. Curtis takes Lewis' place. Curtis punts to Merritt who gains 20 yards. Exeter's ball. Curtis punts to Murchie who gains 10 yards. Murchie is held. Porter fumbles, Power getting the ball for Exeter. Sharon forward passes to Dunn who makes 10 yards. Curtis punts to Thomas who fails to gain. Andover's ball on fumble. Aechtler punts to Sharon who makes 20 yards. Burns punts to Merritt who gains 3 yards. Aechtler makes 2 yards around left end and then he punts to Sharon who makes 5 yards. Ross gains but Exeter is penalized 15 yards for holding. 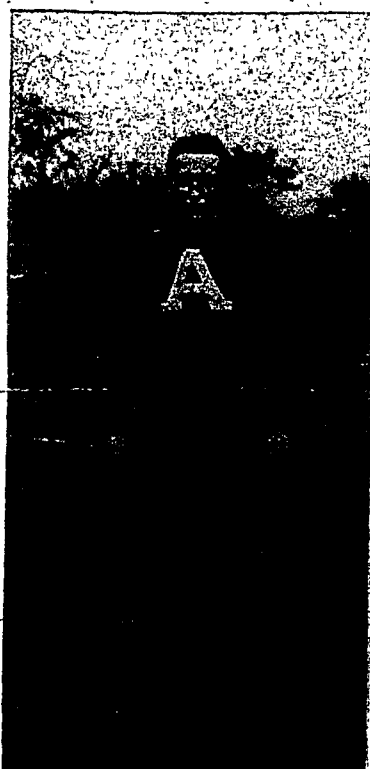

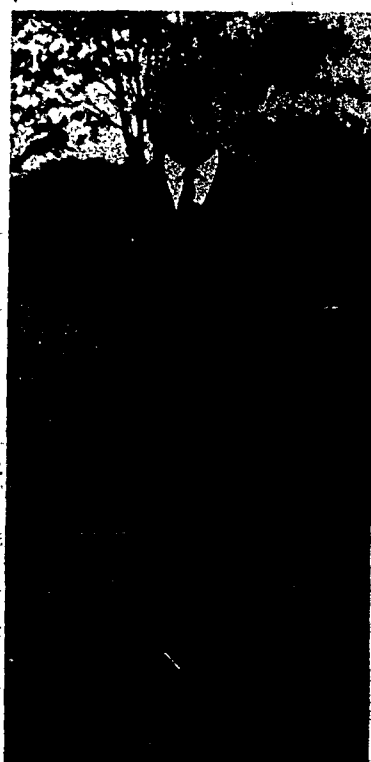

## CAPTAIN POWER

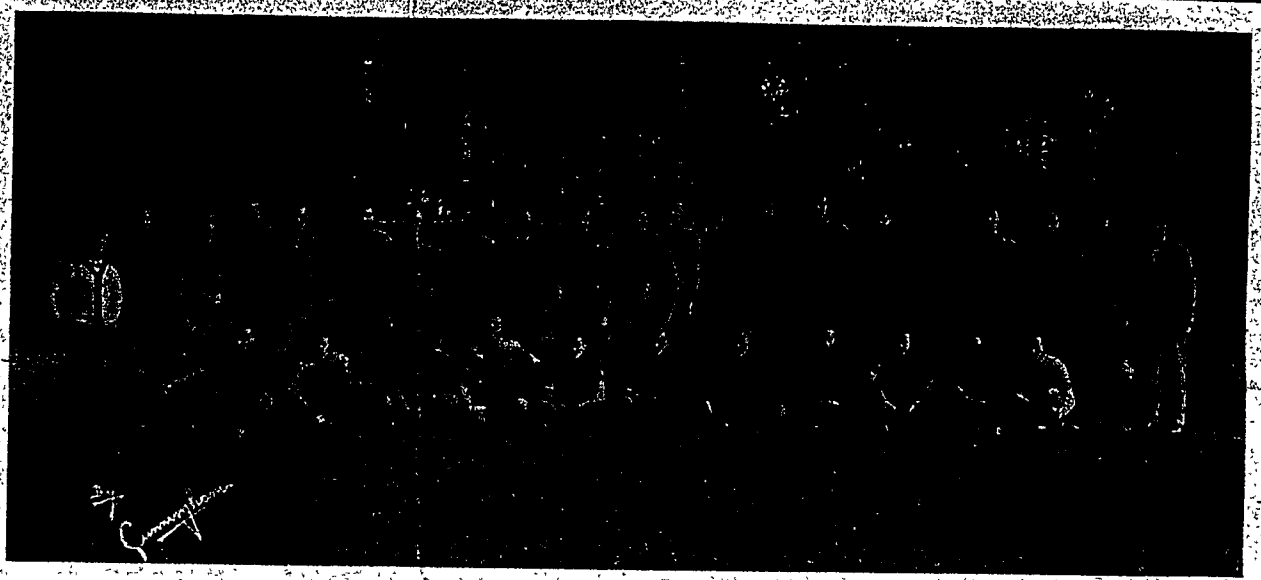

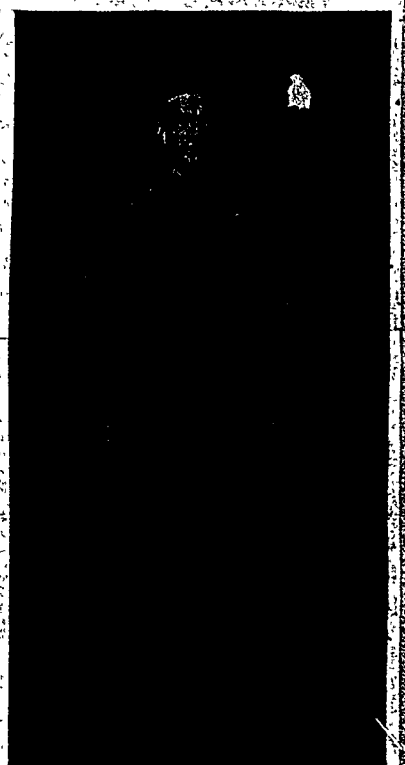
## J. A. BERTOLET

Frank Hinky, who was graduated from Phillips Andover in '94, has been coaching the Yale team at New Haven. Hinky played on the Andover team while he was here, and was famous for his end rushes.
