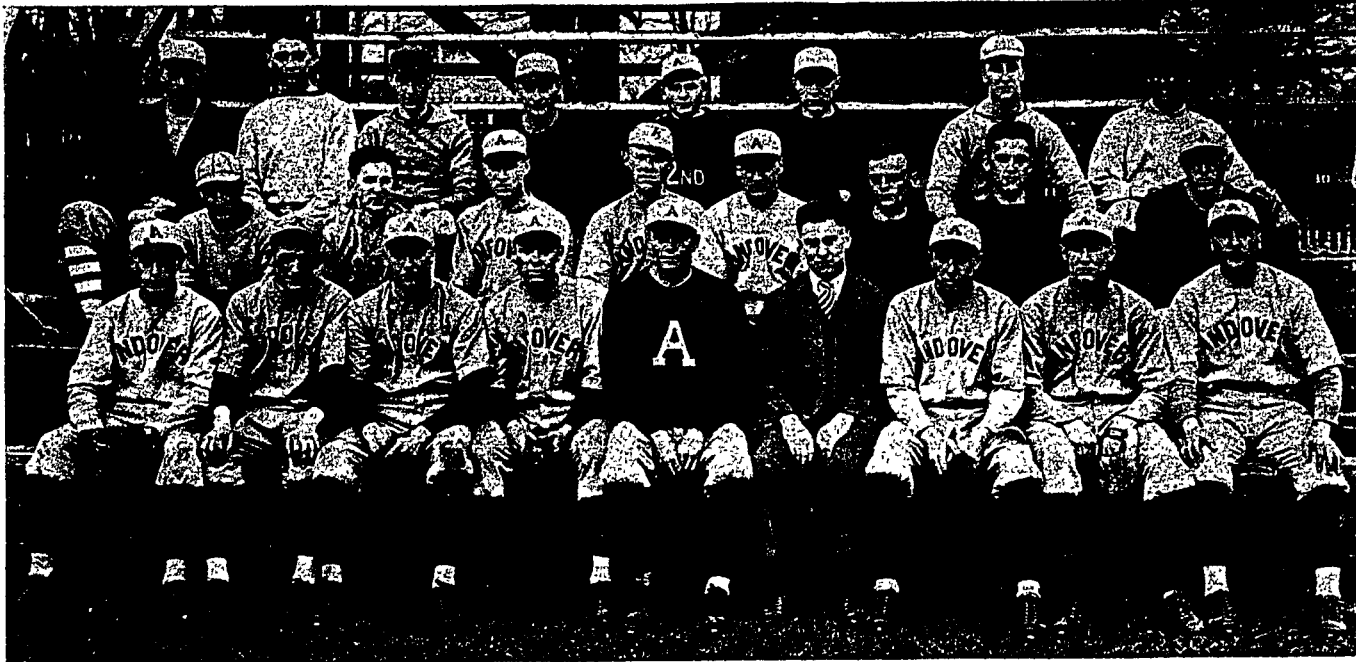

ANDOVER BASEBALL SQUAD

Exeter Wins the Annual Ball Game From Andover on Brothers Field

This afternoon on Brothers Field, the thirty-fifth annual baseball game between Andover and Exeter was played. The Exeter team arrived last night, and, according to the usual custom, the school arrived on a special about 1.30, and marched up under the direction of the cheer leaders to the field, where they took their places back of third. Andover did not arrive until nearly two o'clock, marching onto the field from the far end of the football grounds, and headed by a band. They took the first base bleachers.

The crowd poured in gradually, and before 2.30, the time scheduled for the starting, the stands were well filled.

THE GAME

FIRST INNING

Exeter—Martin was passed. Peters struck out, but Martin got to second on a passed ball. Neal hit to right field, scoring Martin, but was out trying to steal second. Enwright was thrown out at first by Murray.

Andover—Snell's third strike was missed, but he was thrown out at first. Ames was thrown out at first by Hutchinson. Earley walked, but Grant struck out, making the third out.

SECOND INNING

Casey was struck out. Hutchinson reached first on Kinney's juggling of his grounder, but Scott fanned. Hutchinson stole second, but Welles struck out. No hits, no runs.

Sheehan flied out to Casey, and Murray was thrown out at first by Enwright. Hager drew four balls, but Kinney struck out. No hits, no runs.

THIRD INNING

Welles flied out to Earley. Mar-

tin was thrown out at first by Kinney, and Peters followed suit. No hits, no runs.

Captain Swett got a clean single to left field, making Andover's first hit. Snell walked, advancing Swett to second. Ames sacrificed and advanced both Swett and Snell. Swett was out at the plate on Earley's grounder, but Snell advanced to third. Grant flied to Casey. One hit, no runs.

FOURTH INNING

Neal was out at first, Snell to Hager, and Enwright was thrown out at the same base by Captain Swett. Casey flied out to Earley. No hits, no runs.

Sheehan flied out to Neal, and Murray knocked a pop, which was gathered in by Enwright. Hager struck out. No hits, no runs.

FIFTH INNING

Hutchinson grounded to left field for a single, and stole second. Scott got a single, Hutchinson going to third. Scott stole second. Hutchinson scored on Swett's wild pitch, but Sheehan threw to Swett at the plate, catching Scott. O'Connor lined a two-bagger to left, which was too far out for Earley to get. Welles singled to left, scoring O'Connor on a very close decision. Martin flied out to Grant. Peters was thrown out at first by Kinney. Four hits, two runs.

Kinney was thrown out at first by Welles, but Swett walked. Snell flied out to Neal. Swett was out at second, while Ames was safe on fielder's choice. No hits, no runs.

JOHN F. HAGER, JR.

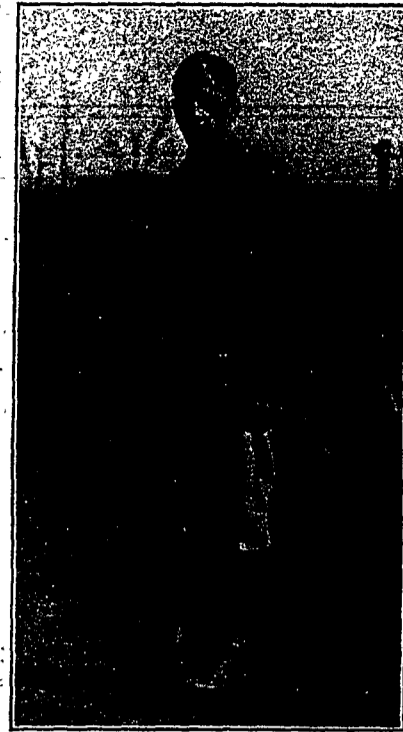

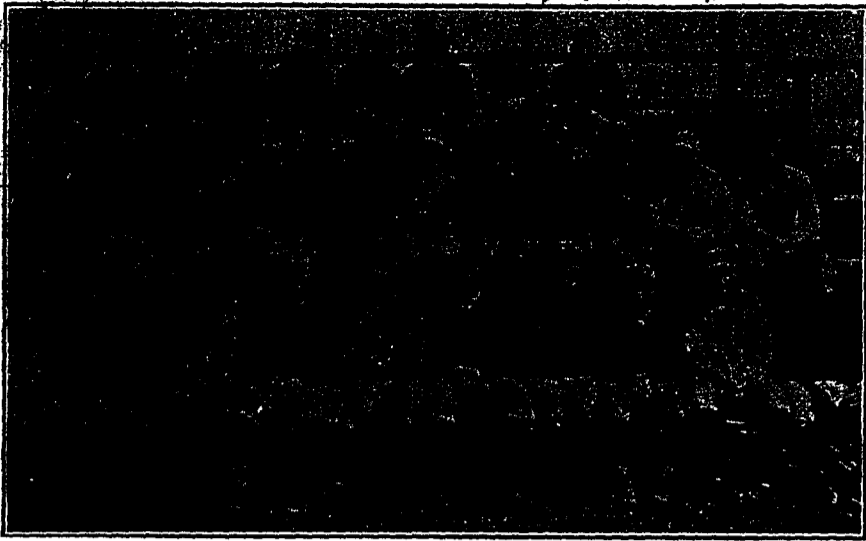

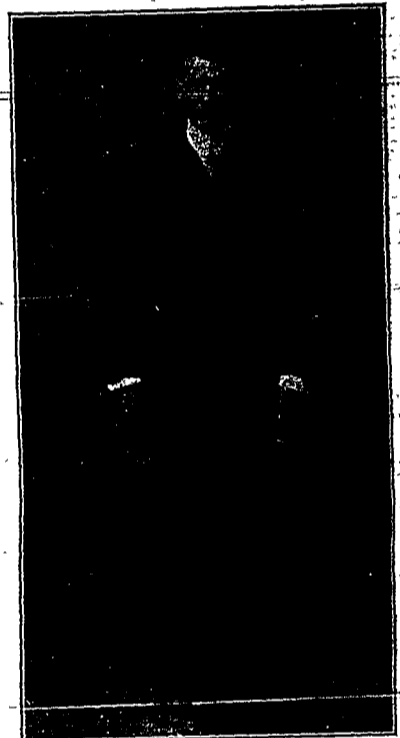
GARDNER E. JOHNSON
