

Four years after Covid-19, has a connected Andover community come back into focus? While about 82% of students considered themselves happy at Andover in both 2019 and 2024, many things are different.

Andover students use social media 0.49 hours more every day than in 2019 (up 24.8%). Today, 13.3% fewer students consider faculty members to be part of their support system. Of the student respondents, 17.4% believe that the Head of School connects with the student body. The academic culture has changed, with 41.7% of students reporting that they have cheated or plagiarized, a 12.9% increase from 2019.

This data comes from answers provided by students to *The Phillipian*'s annual "State of the Academy," an anonymous survey of 146 questions sent out to the student body. This year, 859 students responded, which represents 74.4% of the total student body.




What is your race?\*




What type of community do you currently live in?



What is your assigned sex at birth?






#### **ROMANTIC ORIENTATION**





#### **POLITICS & WORLDVIEW**

Of respondents, 98.1% indicated that they support the "advocacy of equality of the sexes and the establishment of the political, social, and economic rights of the female sex" (Oxford English Dictionary). However, only 67.3% of students considered themselves to be a feminist. Of students, 84.1% believed gun control in the United States of America should be stricter. 76.1% of students indicated that they believe the school has not provided adequate education on Israel and Palestine. When asked about Andover's political leading, 89.7% of students thought that the community has a political leaning to the left, while only 3.2% thought that the community has a leaning to the right.




What is your political leaning?












Andover students reported an average grade point average (GPA) of 5.42, 0.01 higher than last year's average, while the average time spent on homework daily remained the same at 3.8 hours. 78.1% of the Class of 2027 believed that attending Andover has a positive effect on college admissions compared to 68.0% of the Class of 2026 when they were Juniors. While the departments with the most perceived grading disparity remained similar compared to last year, 12.3% fewer respondents selected the Art Department.






Are you currently a student leader (prefect, proctor, Day Student Mentor, EBI Senior, Cluster or School Co-President) at Andover?



How many leadership positions do you hold on campus?






Do you participate in any extracurriculars because you think they will increase your chances of getting into a selective college?





Do you think attending Andover affects your chances of attending a selective college?















At Andover, 55.4% of students have consumed alcohol recreationally, 30.2% have used a form of marijuana, 22.8% have used an e-cigaratte or vaped a nicotine-based product, 16.8% have used tobacco products, 9.3% have used an oral nicotine packet, and 5.5% have used hallucinogens or hard drugs. 













At Andover, 39.8% of students have engaged in sexual activity — defined as digital, oral, anal, online, and/or vaginal sex. Of the respondents, 45.4% have been or are currently in a committed relationship. For students who masturbate, 45.9% of students felt comfortable with telling friends; of those respondents, 70.0% were men and 30.0% were women. Since 2021, the percent of students who think Andover provides adequate sexual education has risen from 62.2% to 86.2%.






















#### **ANTI-RACISM BY RACE**






#### APPROVAL OF HOS WORK BY CLASS YEAR











Do you believe Andover should divest from fossil fuel companies?





Day students compose 26.4% of the Andover student body, and 55.8% of the student body believed that day students are able to integrate enough with boarding students in the Andover community. Of respondents, 24.1% have felt discriminated against at Andover due to their race, and 20.7% of respondents have felt discriminated against due to their gender. When asked about the Empathy, Balance, and Inclusion (EBI) curriculum, 15.3% of respondents think the EBI curriculum at Andover is effective in helping students become better community members, over 5% less than last year.





Percent of respondents, by race, that believe there is a social divide in Andover between students of different races.\*




#### PERCEIVED SOCIOECONOMIC STATUS




#### LEADERSHIP POSITIONS

Percent of respondents, by race, that believe leadership opportunities are influenced by their race.








#### **DISCOMFORT BY GENDER**


#### DISCIPLINE

In 2022, Andover changed its disciplinary process to the "Responses to Student Behaviors" process, and 68.6% of the student body understands the changes that have been implemented. 16.1% of all respondents believed that the new disciplinary system effectively responds to students who are caught breaking school rules. 64.0% of students thinks that the disciplinary system favors students of privileged backgrounds. When correlated with income, 88.9% of respondents whose net family income was less than \$35,000 believed that the disciplinary system favors students of privileged backgrounds, while 57.7% of respondents whose net family income was greater than \$1,000,000 believed that the disciplinary system favors students of privileged backgrounds.

#### **BOARDING VS. DAY STUDENTS AND DISCIPLINARY CONSEQUENCES**

#### DISCIPLINE SYSTEM EFFECTIVENESS BY DISCIPLINE RECIPIENTS




#### WHICH OF THE FOLLOWING DISCIPLINARY CONSEQUENCES HAVE YOU RECEIVED?\*

#### PRIVILEGE IN THE DISCIPLINARY SYSTEM BY NET FAMILY INCOME




